Report on "Budget 2022: Hits and Misses"

Date: 12th February, 2022

The institute organized a guest session on "Budget 2022: Hits and Misses", by Ms. Ritu Dange, under IQAC, dimension four series on 12th February, 2022. She began the session by introduction of the 'union Budget'.

Budget is classified as revenue budget and capital budget. Budget is communication of how the country would be performing in financial terms, for the entire year. Finance minister, presented the budget. The discussion will take place in the house of parliament and then financial bill will be passed. Gati Shakti, MSME, Electric vehicle, Education and Skilling, Health care, Crypto Currencies, were the points discussed by madam. She spoke on 'Hits and Misses' of the Budget 2022.

Ms. Ritu started with Infrastructure Development-(GATI SHAKTI) point. India is expected to become the world's third largest construction market by 2022. FDI investments are expected in this sector. Initiatives like 'Housing for all', 'Smart cities' are already been implemented. Introduction of 'Gati Shakti' started in October 2021. The digital platform that aims to bring 16 ministries together. Six pillars of 'Gati-shakti' are comprehension, prioritization, optimization, synchronization, Analytical and Dynamic. Leveraging private equities are one of the features of the budget.

MSME is the second largest sector after china. It provides a wide range of services and is engaged in the manufacturing of over 6,000 products. This sector receives Thirty percent contribution to GDP and nearly fifty percent contribution in exports. This sector was worst hit sector during pandemic. The extension of relief, that will help MSME to bail out of pandemic to March, 2023. Twenty five percent of defense spending will be made on domestic manufacturer. Tax incentive has been extended to one more year for eligible startups. A provision for increased focus on digital banking, payments and fintech for improving liquidity for MSME has been made. In terms of Educating and Training, India is the second largest market for e-learning after US (KPMG). The edutech market is expected to reach about US\$ 4 billion by 2025. Introduction of one class one TV channel, setting up of foreign universities to offer courses on management,

finance, setting up of national 'Tele mental health program. Crypto-currencies were the last point to summarize. Close to 105 million people in India currently own crypto currencies like Bitcoins, Digital currencies and Ethererum.

Growing awareness and the generation next are more interested in such investments. India will have its own digital currency. Transfer of digital asset to attract a tax rate of thirty percent. TDS at the rate of 1.1% to be deducted on consideration above thresh hold; Gifting digital assets will also be taxable.

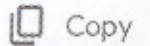

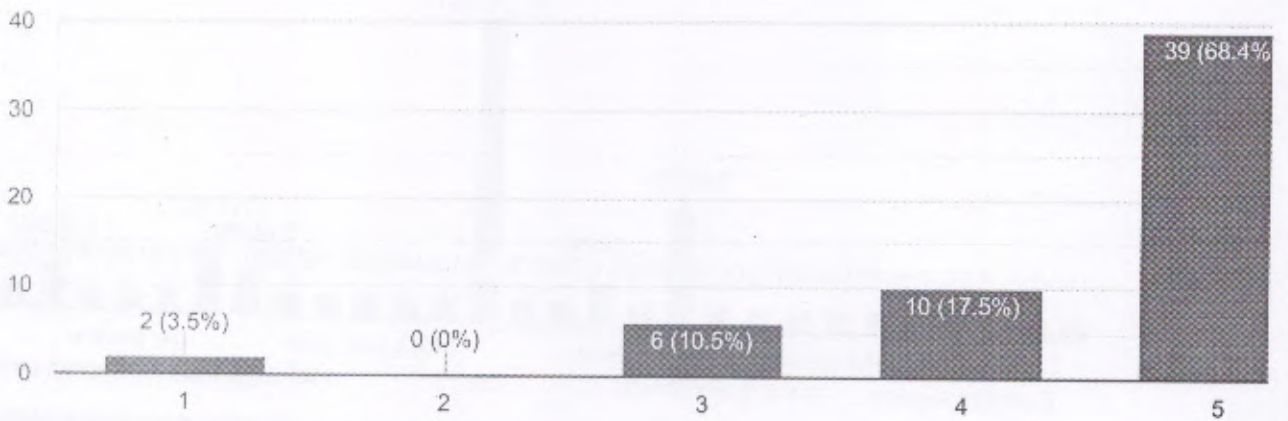
