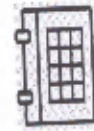

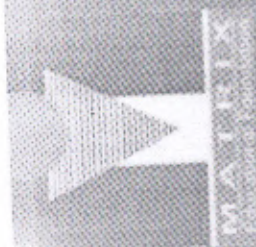

Report on "Fundamentals of Entrepreneurship"
Date: 19th February, 2022

The institute organized a guest session on "Fundamentals of Entrepreneurship", by Dr. Yachana Gharde, under IQAC, dimension four series on 19th February, 2022. She began the session by involving students on the discussion on 'Entrepreneurship'. She explained that, the term entrepreneur is a French word, and is derived from the French word "enterprendre". It means "to undertake". A person who sets up a business or businesses, taking on financial risks in the hope of profit". An entrepreneur is "An individual who bears the risk of operating a business in the face of uncertainty about the future conditions". An 'Entrepreneur' should be Optimistic, Risk taker.

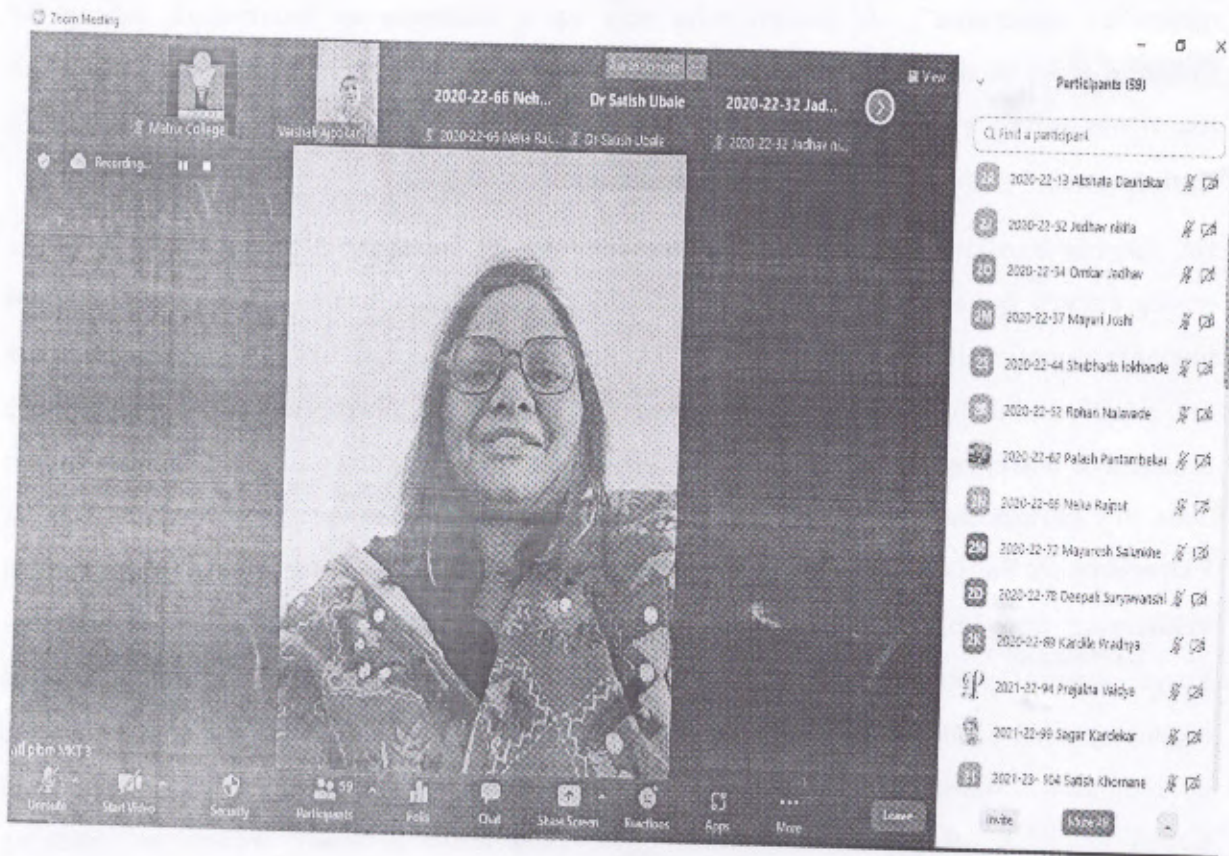
Dr. Gharde explained the types of entrepreneurs: 1) Innovative Entrepreneurs: These entrepreneurs have the ability to think newer, better and more economical ideas of business organization and management. 2) Imitating Entrepreneurs: These entrepreneurs are people who follow the path shown by innovative entrepreneurs. They imitate innovative entrepreneurs because the environment in which they operate is such that it does not permit them to have creative and innovative ideas on their own. 3) Fabian Entrepreneurs Fabian entrepreneurs are those individuals who do not show initiative in visualizing and implementing new ideas and innovations. 4) Social Entrepreneurs – Social entrepreneurs drive social innovation and transformation in various fields including education, health, human rights, workers' rights, environment and enterprise development. While explaining the characteristics, she said that, Innovation and Creativity, Risk taking are prominent ones. Innovation generally refers to changing processes or creating more effective processes, products and ideas. For businesses, this could mean implementing new ideas, creating dynamic products or improving your existing services. Creativity is defined as "the tendency to generate or recognize ideas, alternatives, or possibilities that may be useful in solving problems, communicating with others. Creativity and innovation have always been recognized as a sure path to success



Entrepreneurship is a process in which the entrepreneur establishes new jobs and firms, new Creative and growing organization which is associated with risk, new opportunities and achievement. It results in introducing a new product or service to society.
