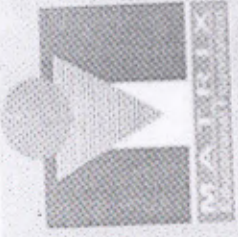

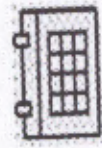

Under the 'Fourth Dimension series' of guest session, the institute conducted a session on "Mentoring Minds for Better and Prosperous Civilisation". Founder Secretary, MEF, Honourable Dr. Shilpa Kulkarni was the key speaker for this session. She started her session on the mindset requirement for prosperous Society. Consideration, National mindset, center of concern & center of influence, greatness, mentoring, quality of life and lead me higher are the pillars which build a prosperous society.

Consideration, is the open and broad spectrum of vision and thought process of a person by understanding others. Co-operate others in accomplishing their tasks. She gave an example of Japan and emphasized on the fact that in spite of been badly hit in World War II, Japan today ranks third in the world economy. Co-operation and determination are an important characteristic features. Instead of focusing on self a person should think and act upon the holistic view of the subject matter.

Having a national mindset for the individuals, organizations, citizens and the society in all is important. She quoted an example from her career on how committed she was in fulfilling the task. In today's generation, the students are not committed and this will create a roadblock in their career. The students have all the facilities, with technological gadgets handy, actually they should be more determined and serious about their career.

Dr. Shilpa spoke on the circle of concern and circle of influence. She said that there has to be congregation in between both of these aspects. I am worried about the pollution aspect in my country is a circle of concern, but I nowhere show this through my action, then its incorrect. Both Circle of concern and circle of influence should map. An individual collaborates with an NGO or contributes to cleanliness through one or other means then it is understood.

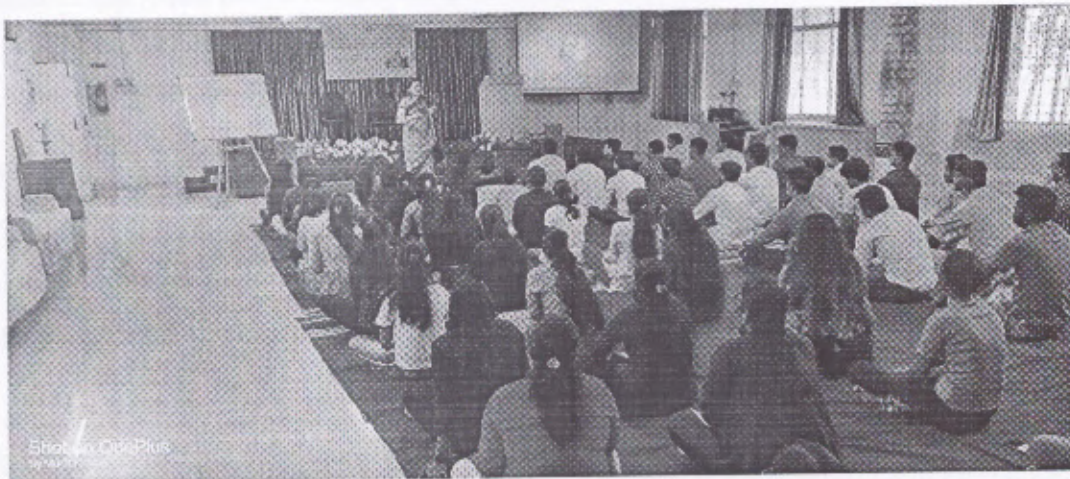

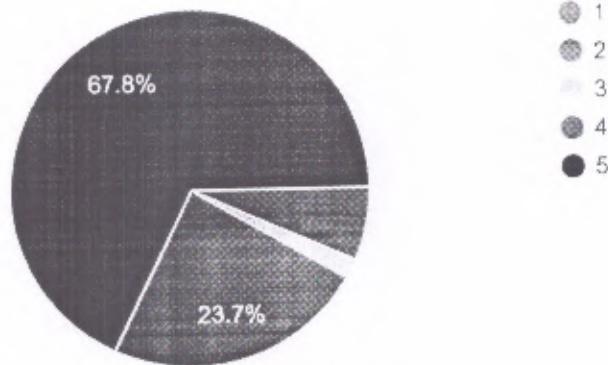
